This toolkit also helps to prepare a pediatric office to apply for, and potentially meet, the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) Physician Practice Connections® Patient Centered Medical Home™ (PPC®-PCMH™) Recognition program requirements.

How can this toolkit help your practice?

The AAP created a crosswalk between each of the toolkit building blocks and the NCQA PPC®-PCMH™ Recognition program 'must pass' elements. Patient care associated with the medical home improves outcomes, such as health status, timeliness of care, family centeredness and family functioning.

The NCQA PPC®-PCMH™ standards provide a way to qualify and quantify care in the medical home. In some practices, scoring at NCQA higher levels has resulted in enhanced payment to the practice.
